Jalan Mamam (Balai Quarry)
Villagers see about three accidents a week at this spot. In some cases, cyclists are flung so hard they land in foliage beyond the road.



Entrance to Chek Jawa Reserve

Signs along the winding, two-way road warn of steep slopes and advise riders to dismount bikes. Large pieces of gravel also make for a bumpy ride and cyclists could lose control of their bikes.



Jalan Wat Siam

Also known as Cemetery Hill, the road was closed after two fatal accidents there. In July 2006, student Zawiyah Mohd Muliana, 18, fell off her bike, and in September 2008, housewife Lee Yan Inn, 41, was flung from her bike. Both died of head injuries.



Jalan Batu Ubin

On March 26, 2011, tourist Nao Xue Ping, 45, from China, was flung from her bike while riding down a slope. She died of head injuries enroute to hospital.



Belatok Hut Road

May 2007: TV personality Dennis Chew jammed his brakes going down a slope and was flung off the bike. He broke his arm and chipped four teeth.
